FEES AND CONDITIONS OF USE

The fees set out in this document apply where the person to be interred, or in respect of whom the right is granted is, or was immediately before his/her death, an inhabitant of the Parish of Uplyme. *In all other cases the fees will be doubled.*

EXCLUSIVE RIGHTS OF BURIAL IN EARTHEN GRAVES

Exclusive Right of Burial is granted for a period of 99 years.

Exclusive Right of Burial of the body of a stillborn child, or a child whose age at the time of death did not exceed 16 years	nil
Exclusive Right of Burial of the body of a person whose age at the time of death exceeded 16 years, in a grave size 9ft by 4ft (275 x 122cm)	£300
Exclusive Right of Burial of the body of a person whose age at the time of death exceeded 16 years, in a grave size 9ft by 6ft (275 x 183cm)	£450
Exclusive Right of Burial of cremated remains	£75

INTERMENTS

- Interments are only to take place between 9am and 4pm on Monday to Friday.
- The Council does not undertake the digging of graves. The digging, backfilling and reinstatement of graves is the responsibility of the undertakers.
- Depth of graves not to exceed 6ft (183cm).
- Reinstatement includes the requirement, after a period of six months to allow for settlement, that all graves must then be levelled and grass reinstated in a minimum of 4inches (10cms) of top soil. In the absence of such reinstatement, but not until seven months after the date of interment, the Council will complete the work, without notice, and the cost shall be repaid to the council by the undertakers.

Interments in Uplyme Cemetery are allowed only on acceptance of the above conditions

Interment of the body of a stillborn child, or a child whose age at the time of death did not exceed 16 years, in a child's grave	Nil
Interment of the body of a person whose age at the time of death exceeded 16 years	£150
Interment of cremated remains	£50

MONUMENTS, GRAVESTONES. TABLETS AND MONUMENTAL INSCRIPTIONS

Only a headstone, vase or tablet, which conforms to the dimensions given below, may be placed in Uplyme Cemetery. Prior approval must be obtained from the Parish Clerk.

Fees for the right to place on a grave or plot in respect of which the Exclusive Right of Burial has been granted:

A headstone or cross, which must be of agreed design, not exceeding 4ft in height and 3ft in width (122 x 91cm)	£75
Inscribed Vase (in the new cemetery, on plinth only) at head of grave, not exceeding 1ft 6in (46cm)	£40
Tablet on cremation plot or grave, not exceeding 1ft 6in (46cm) square, set level with ground	£40

Further inscriptions on existing monuments do not attract a separate charge.

If other kinds of monument are required (for example in the old cemetery), contact the Parish Clerk in the first instance to discuss fees.
