## NOTES OF MEETING ON WEDNESDAY, 5TH MARCH 2014 AT THE OLD BLACK DOG, UPLYME

1. Minutes of last meeting accepted.
2. Matters Arising – no matters arising not covered by agenda items.
3. Correspondence – SW Water no plans for next 25 years. King George V no plans except to re roof the old pavilion and some resurfacing work. Awaiting other responses.
4. Questionnaire and newsletter – Thanks recorded to those who spent time printing and stuffing envelopes.
