## Purchase a Grave Space Uplyme Cemetery

An Exclusive Right of Burial (ERB) is granted for 99 years from the date of purchase.

The ERB permits the remains of the person(s) named on the certificate to be interred in the grave space, or those of their next of kin (inheritors). The permission of the person who owns the right must be obtained for the interment of any other person's remains, so you may wish to nominate a representative or next of kin in the second part of the form.

The number of interments possible depends on whether the grave is single or double depth, and whether full remains or ashes are to be interred. If in doubt, please consult the Clerk.
