Note: The Births and Deaths Registration Act 1926 requires that, before burials can be effected, the Council must have received a certificate to confirm that the death has been registered, or confirmation that the Registrar has received notice of the death, or a Coroner's order for burial. Interments of ashes must be accompanied by a Certificate of Cremation.

Please note: if an Exclusive Right of Burial in a grave has been purchased from the Council, the consent of the owner of the exclusive right is needed for the burial or ashes interment for anyone other than that of the owner of the right. Uplyme Parish Council accepts no liability for consents. The written consent is not necessary when the remains are those of the person whose name is on the deed of grant.
